Good afternoon.

Superintendent Eddie Campbell here,
with an important announcement concerning instruction
in all Monongalia County Schools
in the coming weeks.

Due to the continuing spike in COVID-19 incidence in Mon County,
all county students
will receive instruction
through our Distance Learning model
beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, December 9th.

Let me repeat that:
All Mon County students –
including our Blended Learning students –
will become Distance learners
beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, December 9th.

Distance Learning only
will continue for the rest of December.

Depending on the county's COVID incidence
over the next few weeks,
we anticipate reinstating our Blended Learning model
when classes resume
on Monday, January 4th.

In the meantime,
Mon County Schools staff
will continue to report to their schools and offices.

Please note
that free lunches will be available to all students
for curbside pick-up
through December 21st.

Parents must register on the Mon County Schools website
by 9 A-M daily
to reserve their children's meals.
